PLEASE CHECK THE DATES WITH YOUR CALENDARS AND UNDERSTAND AND AGREE TO THE OBLIGATIONS BELOW:

1. Understand how important attendance is, and attend all the scheduled rehearsals and concerts of the College/Youth Symphony. **Only two excused absences** are allowed this semester, and one must notify Dr. Cowan or Ms. Davies, at the latest, before 4 p.m. on Sunday. Excused absences include illness, family obligations, etc. If a student misses more than two rehearsals, Dr. Cowan will decide whether the student will receive credit for the course, perform in the concert, make-up missed rehearsals, etc., on an individual basis. Notify the director or the manager as soon as possible when you become ill or problems with the schedule arise.
2. If you cannot attend a rehearsal or concert, if you have music needed for a concert or rehearsal, **you are responsible for getting the music to the event** so that someone may cover your part. This applies particularly to solo wind and brass players.
3. You are responsible for the care of your music. All music must be returned at the end of the semester. You may be charged for lost or damaged music.
