Concerto Competitions

Saturday November 5, 10am - 2pm

Virtuosi-In-Progress and College/Youth Symphony Competitions will begin at 10am in the Nadia and Max Shepard Recital Hall, located in College Hall at the State University of New York at New Paltz. The competitions are open to the public, and judged by a panel of area musicians. Students may audition for two opportunities simultaneously: Solo performances with the HVP at the Young People's Concerts; Marietta Cheng, conductor, in the Spring 2012. Solo performances with College/Youth Symphony, Carole Cowan, conductor, May 2012.

Application: Please send the attached application form with teacher's signature and a check for \$15 made payable to SUNY New Paltz. Application must be sent by, and post-marked, no later than Oct. 27, 2011.

Repertoire: Contestants should be prepared to perform 10 minutes of a solo orchestral piece, or a movement from a concerto **by memory**. However, the winner's performance with the HVP will be limited to six minutes and the conductor will approve any cuts needed.

Notification: Candidates accepted for the competition will be notified by November 2, 2011 of audition time. Winners will be announced at the end of the competitions.

Accompanists: Contestants must provide their own piano accompanist (recommendations upon request)

HUDSON VALLEY PHILHARMONIC VIRTUOSO-IN- PROGRESS

Two winners will perform as soloists with the Hudson Valley Philharmonic at Young Peoples Concerts March 20, 21 and 22 of 2012. The concerts are scheduled during school time for school audiences. Previous winners* are not eligible on the same instrument and may compete in a different age division.

Acceptable instruments: Any orchestral strings, including harp; woodwinds, brass, or percussion instruments (excluding piano and voice).

Age Divisions: Candidates may be divided into two categories: Senior, ages 14-19; Junior, ages 13 and under. A winner may be chosen in each division at the digression of the judges.

Residency: All candidates must reside or attend school in one of the following Mid-Hudson Valley counties: Columbia, Dutchess, Greene, Putnam, Orange, Sullivan, or Ulster.

** Winners will be asked by the conductor to shorten their performance selection for the concert to six minutes*



One of the Hudson Valley Philharmonic's most important dimensions is its youth program and its Young People's Concerts. We examined our education program with the consultation of The Julliard School, Lincoln Center Institute and New York Philharmonic Arts-In-Education specialists. This resulted in a dynamic new format that provides students with the opportunity to hear fine music played by a full orchestra, while relating the listening experience to academic and personal learning.

One winner will be selected to perform as a soloist. with the College/Youth Symphony in their May 13, 2012. Performance. Competitors must be members (in good standing) of the College/Youth Symphony. During the 2011/2012 year. There is no age restriction.
