# Concerto Competitions

## Saturday November 4, 2017, 1 - 5pm

Virtuosi-In-Progress and College-Youth Symphony Competitions will begin at 1 pm in the Nadia & Max Shepard Recital Hall, located in College Hall on the campus of SUNY New Paltz. The competitions are open to the public, and judged by a panel of area musicians. Students may audition for two opportunities simultaneously: (a) solo performances with the HVP at the Spring 2018 Young People's Concerts with Christine Howlett conducting; and/or (b) a solo performance with College-Youth Symphony at their Spring 2018 Concert with Dr. Christiana Fortune-Reader conducting.

**Application:** Please send the attached application form with teacher's signature and a check for \$20 made payable to SUNY New Paltz. Application must be sent by, and post-marked, no later than October 26, 2017. NO EXCEPTIONS.

**Repertoire:** Contestants should be prepared to perform 9-11 minutes of a solo orchestral piece or movement from a concerto **by memory** (optional for winds and brass). The soloist may elect to include the cadenza, but is not required to. The winner's performance with the HVP is limited to **4-5 minutes**. The conductor will approve the marked cuts included in the application.

**Notification:** Candidates accepted for the competition will be notified by November 1st 2017 of their audition time. Winners will be announced at the end of the competitions.

**Accompanists:** Contestants must provide their own piano accompanist (recommendations upon request)

## HUDSON VALLEY PHILHARMONIC VIRTUOSO-IN-PROGRESS COMPETITION

One winner will perform as soloist with the Hudson Valley Philharmonic at Young People's Concerts in April 2018. The concerts are scheduled during school day for school audiences. Previous winners\* are not eligible to compete on the same instrument in the same competition. They may compete on a different instrument, in the other competition and/or in a different age division.

**Acceptable instruments:** Any orchestral strings, including harp; woodwinds, brass, or percussion instruments (excluding piano and voice).

**Age Divisions (for VIP only):** Candidates may be divided into two categories: Senior, ages 14-19; Junior, ages 13 and under. A winner may be chosen in either division at the discretion of the judges.

**Residency:** All candidates must reside or attend school in one of the following Mid-Hudson Valley counties: Columbia, Dutchess, Greene, Putnam, Orange, Sullivan, or Ulster.

*\* Winners will be asked by the conductor to shorten their performance selection for the concert to 4-5 minutes. All contestants must include cuts with measure numbers as part of their application, which*



One of the Hudson Valley Philharmonic's most important dimensions is its youth program and its Young People's Concerts. We examined our education program with the consultation of The Julliard School, Lincoln Center Institute and New York Philharmonic Arts-In-Education specialists. This resulted in a dynamic new format that provides students with the opportunity to hear fine music played by a full orchestra, while relating the listening experience to academic and personal learning.
